## **Local Updates**

**Crouchlands Development –** No further updates at this stage. The Planning Appeal inquiry is ongoing from 1<sup>st</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> October and we hope to be able to provide an outcome shortly afterwards.

**Lagoon 3 –** The preliminary hearing of the defendant's appeal took place on 19<sup>th</sup> September at Lewes Crown Court. This hearing was primarily administrative to discuss deadlines for submission of documentation and to set the date for the final hearing. This will take place on 6<sup>th</sup> February 2025 at Lewes Crown Court.

**Local Plan –** The Local Plan examination is currently underway in the Committee Rooms at Chichester District Council and will run from the 1<sup>st</sup> to the 10<sup>th</sup> of October before a break, resuming on Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> November. **Land West of Cornwood (Townfield), Kirdford –** The developer of this very long running application has now provided documents for a revised scheme, reducing the number of dwellings from 70 to 50 (amongst other changes). We are in regular contact with the officer dealing with this application and will continue to push for a determination before the end of this year and bring this to a close for residents of Kirdford.

**Loxwood Shop –** Antler Homes have confirmed that they have exchanged contracts with a purchaser for the retail premises and that they expect to issue a press release with details of the shop owner in the very near future.

# **Stopham Mount**

We're launching a crowdfunding campaign this month to help us keep a rare local Saxon find within Chichester District.

The rare Anglo-Saxon gold and garnet pyramidical sword mount, which was discovered in 2022 near Stopham in the Chichester District, dates back to 600-700 AD and is only the second of its kind to be found in West Sussex.

If successful in crowdfunding, the local treasure would be displayed in the Novium museum's first-floor gallery, within an area dedicated to Saxon history. The gallery is free of charge to visit, making the piece accessible to all.
