Local Updates

Foxbridge Golf Club – The application for the wellbeing and leisure development at the former Foxbridge Golf Club is now scheduled not coming to planning committee in February with the earliest expected date to be April. This is due to the length of time that the application has been live, and officers now need to reconsult on several aspects which are no longer up to date. We continue to support the Parish Councils in opposing this application, which is not suitable for the area and our infrastructure. It is noted that whilst there is strong opposition to this, there are also many supportive comments. We will be asking officers that a robust S106 is in place to safeguard against aspects such as change of use.

Local Government Reorganisation – West Sussex County Council made a request to central government that the county council elections be postponed due to ongoing preparation for devolution. West Sussex County Council was one of twenty nice local authorities who made this request. Whilst it has been accepted by central government it is subject to a legal challenge and as such CDC, who administer the election, will continue with preparations in the event the decision is overturned.

CDC Wide Updates

Food Waste Recycling – As previously communicated this is due to be rolled out across the district in May 2026. CDC will commence communication to residents throughout February (placed on residents bins) outlining what they can expect to receive. Throughout March kitchen caddies and outside bins will be delivered to residents. This is a huge project covering 300 square miles so the service will need to be delivered in stages across the district.
