### Dear Beverley,

Attached is a list of the four entries in the District Historic Environment Record (excluding listed buildings) which fall within a 1km radius of the centre of the proposed allocation site. None has a heritage significance that would be affected by development of the site to the extent that mitigation measures would be warranted. I can confirm that there are no known Scheduled Monuments or Historic gardens in the vicinity.

The English Heritage/West Sussex CC Historic Landscape Characterisation lists the area of the site as medieval aggregate assart (i.e. groups of irregular assart fields derived from the general, unplanned clearance of woodland). However, it does not appear from the aerial photographs that any of the field boundaries retains any very significant features. The Kirdford Tithe Award (1847) lists the area as Owlett Field (arable), owned by Henry Frederick Napper, occupied by Henry Wellen.

Please let me know if you think I've missed anything.

I shall have a look at the draft when I have a moment – probably early next week.
